Junior Market Livestock Sale



OFFICIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

As a prospective buyer attending the Delta County Fair Junior Market Livestock Sale, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions and fully acknowledge that your receipt of a buyer's number is acknowledgement you agree to be bound thereby.

All purchasers of animals at the sale are required to have a Buyer's number to bid and must register prior to bidding by full name, current mailing address, and phone number.

AGENTS- If you are acting as an agent for a business or individual, please obtain a separate buyer number for each party whom you are representing. By obtaining a buyer's number as an agent of an individual and/or company, you acknowledge that you are responsible for the full settlement of all charges incurred for such individual/company prior to departing the sale premises.

PAYMENT- Full Payment is due at the TIME OF THE SALE, prior to departing the sale premises. Please make checks payable to: Delta County Junior Market Livestock Sale. Interest will be applied to all outstanding balances if not paid within 14 days.

DISPUTE BETWEEN BIDDERS - If any dispute shall arise between two or more bidders as to an animal, the auctioneer shall have the final say in the dispute and may continue the bidding/put the lot up for sale again until the lot is sold. The decision of the auctioneer shall be final and absolute.

PROCESSOR - Upon check-in, all buyers must pre-designate a processor for all animals purchased. This is recorded on the front of your buyer number for your reference. **The processor you declare at check-in will be utilized for ALL PURCHASES MADE, unless notification is received in writing at the conclusion of the sale.** If you would like to change your declared processor for a specific animal or species, you must complete a **CHANGE OF PROCESSOR FORM** at checkout. Failure to complete such form will result in all your purchases being sent to the processor/destination you declared at check-in.

All Livestock Sales conducted at the Junior Market Livestock Sale are FINAL. Upon the conclusion of the bidding and being declared the final bidder, you become owner of such animal. The Junior Market Livestock Sale Committee will then make arrangements with the processor or feedlot you designated to pickup the animal(s) you purchased following the sale.

As a buyer and owner of a livestock animal which you designate to be sent to a meat processor and/or feedlot, it is YOUR responsibility to contact such facility and make proper arrangements and payment for such services as they are NOT included in the cost of your animal. Contact the Livestock Office for a list of Processors/Feed Lots and their contact information.

THE DELTA COUNTY FAIRBOARD AND JUNIOR MARKET LIVESTOCK SALE COMMITTEE ARE ONLY AGENTS OF THE SALE AND MAKE NO PROMISES OR ENDORSEMENTS. BY PURCHASING AN ANIMAL, YOU HEREBY AGREE TO ABSOLVE THE DELTA COUNTY FAIRBOARD, LIVESTOCK SALE COMMITTEE AND ITS DESIGNEES OF ALL FINANCIAL OR LEGAL RESPONSIBILITIES FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGES INCURRED AS A RESULT OF YOUR PURCHASE. ANY AND ALL ARRANGMENTS BETWEEN YOU AND A MEAT PROCESSOR IS OF YOUR OWN ACCORD AND NOT THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE LIVESTOCK COMMITTEE OR THE DELTA COUNTY FAIR.
